Prof. Hiroshi Amano Nobel Prize winner in Physics 2014



Prof. Hiroshi Amano is a Japanese physicist and inventor specializing in the field of semiconductor technology. For his work, he was awarded the 2014 Nobel Prize in Physics, together with Isamu Akasaki and Shuji Nakamura, for the invention of efficient blue lightemitting diodes which has enabled bright and energy-saving white light sources.
